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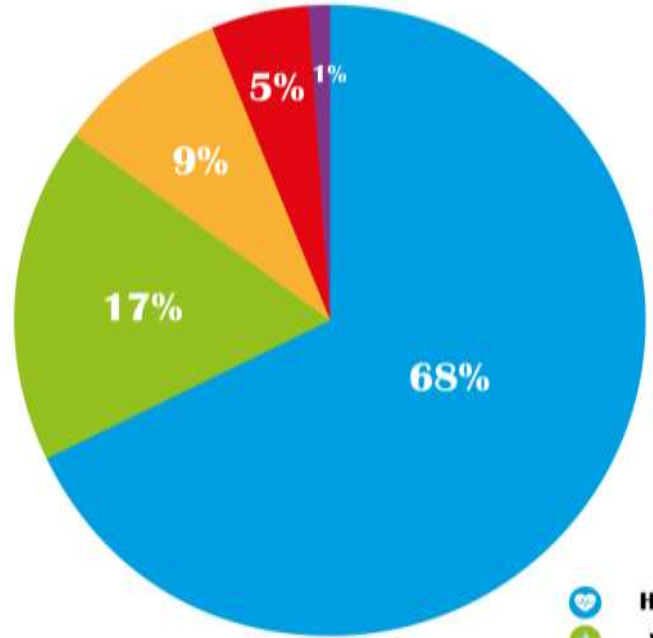

QRC Approach (general)

- Needs based;
- sustainability and local ownership;
- Working in partnership within and outside RCRC Movement;
- Measuring results and scale up evidence based programmes.



QRC Approach (Conflict related)

- Emergency preparedness (capacity building);
- Emergency response (close cooperation with MOH, PRCS, municipalities, NGOs);
- Early recovery;
- Long term development.



Goal

Comprehensive quality services for establishing **dignified** and **protective** environments for most vulnerable communities.

1. Competent and effective local structures;
2. Upgraded Well-equipped facilities (i.e. Health, WASH);
3. Well-trained and qualified service providers;
4. Filled gaps in service provision.



1. Competent and effective local structures

- Strategic Planning (SHP 2014-2019)
 - SO2: Foster emergency preparedness and critical care services at community, pre-hospital and hospital levels.
- Building Managerial capacities
 - Master in Health Management & Health Policy;
 - Master in Disaster Management in the Health Sector.



1. Competent and effective local structures

- Cooperation & Collaboration with PRCS, ICRC, Health Cluster



2. Upgraded Well-equipped facilities

– Establishing/upgrading health facilities

- Renovation of Al-Quds hospital;
- Renovation of old SB at Shifa hospital including OPs & ICU;
- Establishing new SSB at Shifa hospital with add. 8 OPs & about 200 beds;
- Establishing new Rehab. Dept. at Al-Amal hospital.



2. Upgraded Well-equipped facilities

– Equipping Health Facilities

- EGH (Neurosurgery dep., MRI, CT);
- SSB (12 surgical disciplines).

– Wash projects



3. Well-trained and qualified service providers

- Around 20 specialists back to Gaza, most of them emergency related specialties.
